Dr. Whitney, as principal of Five Palms I would like to thank you and your GAMER staff for making our school a better learning community. The GAMER program has helped inspire student for a better future and promoted attendance with positive incentives and purpose.

While GAMER has supported Five Palms for a third year, the program successfully addressed and focused on motivating students to stay in school, respect and plan for a good future career which students, parents and teachers love.

Currently all public schools are experiencing a funding crisis that has affected school budgets. While finding the funds is at the hands of our legislatures, you with the GAMER have developed a program to increase funds at the campus level. The school's daily attendance is what determines how much funds will be provided by the state to the district thus the school. At Five Palms our attendance usually fell as number 9 or 10 which is at the bottom of the list based on the district's 10 elementary schools.

Absenteeism at Five Palms was very high. We averaged about 93% attendance on a given week. This all changed when GAMER added another facet to the program that addressed attendance this February, 2011 school year. Five Palms has increased attendance. Our school is no longer at the bottom of the heap. Students were very excited to come to school because of the GAMER perfect attendance incentive which included monthly field trips and weekly rewards i.e. raffling off a basket full of wonderful prizes, tickets to Sea World, Spurs game, movie passes and much more.

When students are in school they learn and our TAKS preliminary scores show the affects of perfect attendance and positive attitude that the GAMER has instilled in our students. The number of discipline referrals to the office has drastically decreased from 35 a week to 4 or 5 a week within the first year the GAMER program intervened 3 years ago and continues to make a big difference at our campus.

## Five Palms Daily Attendance Average:

Mobility rate at Five Palms is very high, about 35% and daily attendance at 92% and some days as low at 86%. On February 2011 the GAMER Perfect Attendance incentives program took off at Five Palms raising our daily attendance to an average of 95 to 97%. For the month of May, all students in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade with perfect attendance got to go on a field trip to the Corpus Christi, Texas State Aquarium. Wow! The parents, students, staff and community were so excited! Five Palm students had a great learning experience in Corpus Christi. At least 75% of the students had never been to Corpus Christi.

### **Academic: TAKS Scores for Five Palms**

With the support of GAMER our school TAKS scores have shown yearly improvement. Student can not learn unless he/she is at school and he/she will not learn unless there is a purpose. The GAMER provides the incentives and purpose.
